The 8 Teen Challenge Canada Centres are affiliated with more than 1400 centres in over 125 countries throughout the world. TEEN CHALLENGE

The Teen Challenge program uses a holistic faith-based approach to treatment and recovery, rather than the traditional 12-step program. We define success in recovery as abstinence, instead of a harm-reduction strategy. The program is 2^{nd} to none, due to the integration of a spiritual emphasis that is Christ-centred in treatment and care. The cost of the year-long program is supported by donations from the community, with only a \$1100 fee required from the applicant.

In April 2018 my family and I moved to the Renfrew area to get the Eastern Ontario Men's Centre up and operational. We needed to raise \$1.6 million to get the projects completed, and to build a "sustainability reserve" so that once we open our doors, we will not be closing them. We reached our \$1.6 million Capital Campaign goal on January 30, 2021. On July 21 our National Leadership gave us the opening target date of October 4 to receive students into our program. This is an achievable goal, but could be complicated due to Covid 19 or delayed shipping of products that we need to

have in place before we open. Nailing down contractors for a couple of small projects could be a struggle as well.

God used this ministry to save my life, and I am called to work in vocational ministry for Teen Challenge transitioning to the Centre Dir. over the next couple of weeks.
