TEEN CHALLENGE

The Teen Challenge program uses a holistic faith-based approach treatment and recovery, rather than the traditional 12-step program. We define success in recovery as abstinence, instead of a harm-reduction strategy. The program is 2nd to none, due to the integration of a spiritual emphasis that is Christ-centred in treatment and care. In April 2018 my family and I moved to the Renfrew area to get the Eastern Men's Centre Ontario uр operational. We needed to raise \$1.6 million to get the projects completed, and to build a "sustainability reserve" so that once we open our doors, we will not be closing them.
