THIS WEEK: WORLD RENEW - UKRAINE RESPONSE: World Renew has joined the Humanitarian Coalition's joint appeal for the Ukraine Crisis through our membership in Canadian Foodgrains Bank. We are working with our global networks in the region to respond to the needs of vulnerable families impacted by the conflict in Ukraine. We are supporting these peer organizations by providing essential items for people fleeing for safety to neighbouring countries. In Slovakia, we are providing temporary shelters, emergency food, and emergency non-food items such as blankets, linens, mattresses, and basic hygiene items.
