COUNCIL REPORT FOR JANUARY 2023: It's almost 3 years since the we first heard about Covid-19 and the pandemic restricted our lives and caused gatherings, even in-person worship services, to change and even stop for a time. During all this time the council of our church continued to meet, via ZOOM when necessary, and focused on how best to minister to the congregation and how to continue having worship services even if everyone had to worship in their homes. Now that the pandemic is mostly behind us, council has begun a discussion on the strengths of our congregation and in which areas we need to refine our ministry.
