COUNCIL REPORT FOR FEBRUARY AND MARCH 2023: The following is a summary of the major matters dealt with by council during the last two months:

- 1. The financial statements for the year ending Dec. 31, 2022, were approved by council. Council and the FAC (Finance and Admin Committee) thank God for blessing the congregation financially again this past year and thank the congregation for their generosity so that all the expenses could be paid and ministry share commitments met. A surplus of \$1,189.99 was transferred to the Building Fund. The statements will be distributed before the spring congregational meeting.
- 2. Council has spent much time discussion the "direction" of our church. More details will be presented soon and the congregation will be asked for input at the spring meeting.
- 3. The spring congregational meeting is scheduled for Sunday, May 7, after a potluck after the worship service. All members are encouraged to attend and participate in the discussion about direction and implementation.
- 4. Classis Eastern Canada met at Barhaven CRC on March 3 and 4. Pastor Gregg chaired the meeting and Pastor Joe, Derrick Noort and Andrew VanVeen were the delegates. The agenda included the examination of candidate Ryan Farrell, the new Ottawa Campus Chaplain. Ryan replaces Chaplain Sid Ypma and we pray that God will bless this ministry to university students. The agenda also included two overtures which will be sent to synod requesting that synod reconsider the decision of 2022 concerning human sexuality.
- 5. Council has also begun the process of finding one new deacon and two new elders. More information is elsewhere in the bulletin.
